# HOW TO MAKE A FATHER'S DAY CARD



To make your Li'l Woodzeez Father's Day Card you will need:

- sheet of thin card or cereal box
- PVA glue
- the base of a plastic bottle (to mix the glue)
- medium size glue brush
- craft knife
- a cutting mat
- ruler
- old ballpoint pen with no ink
- a sheet of coloured paper
- small length of cord
- coloured pencils, felt tip pens or paints to colour in the card.

**Note:** Cover your glue container with a plastic bag and hold it in place with an elastic band when not in use. Clean your brushes straight after use to maintain the bristles.



1. Mix one-part water with one-part PVA glue in a small container; it should be the consistency of milk. Glue the template to one side of the cereal box card and the coloured paper to the reverse of the card.



2. Line up the ruler along the dash lines and score the card with an old empty ballpoint pen as shown.

3. Cut out the holes in the bow and arms first, before cutting out the card elements.

4. Glue a thin strip of white paper across the back of the card and down the sides of the card as shown.



5. Glue the two hands to the front of the card as shown using full strength PVA glue.

6. With coloured pencils, felt tip pens or paints color in the card.



7. Fold the cord in half and thread in through the hole in the ribbon. Thread the two ends of the cord through the loop as indicated and pull tight.

8. Thread the two ends of the cord through the hole in the centre of the card and then thread each end of the cord through the holes in the arms as shown.

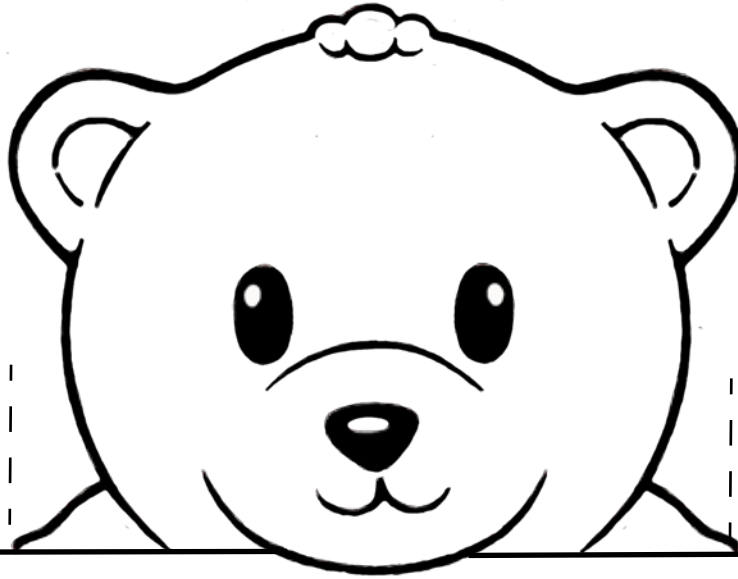
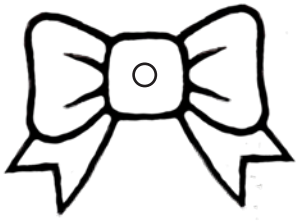
9. Shut the card with the bow on the outside, pulling the cords tight as indicated.

10. Weigh down the card and glue the end of the cords to the back of the arms with full strength PVA glue.

11. Lift and twist the ribbon, then pull to open the card.
